Dorothy Day, Founder of the Catholic Worker Movement, stated that everything a baptized person does each day should be directly or indirectly related to the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. One of The Corporal Works of Mercy is feeding the hungry. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) is helping feed the hungry with the food pantry located at the St. James the Less Church at 1614 Oakland Park in North Linden. Volunteers from parishes throughout the diocese pack groceries each evening Monday through Friday. The SVDP Conference at St. Timothy contributes financial support and provides teams that volunteer at the St. James Pantry to supply groceries to over 700 needy clients each month.
