We will be looking at the book of *Hebrews: The New and Eternal Covenant*, presented by Andrew Swafford and Jeff Cavins. According to the publisher, Ascension Press, "The book of Hebrews is like a little Catechism. It is steeped in rich truths that are foundational to our Catholic Faith, but its highly refined theological concepts can be difficult for even the most seasoned Bible scholars to unpack... It draws connections between the Old and New Testaments, the Liturgy, the Eucharist, the priesthood, and so much more. 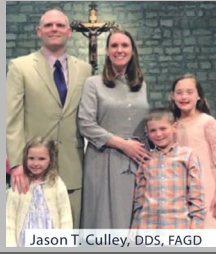
