PASTOR'S DESK

From the Desk of Father Dan

Recently, Bishop Fernandes has approved new directives for the distribution of the Precious Blood at Mass. You may recall that this past spring, people were able to receive Communion from the cup that was



offered at one Mass on the weekend. The opportunity to receive under both species has now been increased. Basically, the cup may be offered at Sunday Masses, Solemnities, and Feasts. Also, the Precious Blood may be offered on special occasions like First Communions, Confirmations, Weddings; but it is not to be offered at Mass every day. Receiving Communion under both species is a clearer sign of the Eucharist, but remember that a person receives the entire Eucharist under one species.

In order for the parish to increase the opportunities to receive from the cup, we need to have a schedule of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist who are dependable, rather than the current situation where people just come up out of the congregation. I appreciate their willingness to serve, but often their attire is not appropriate for a minister of the Eucharist. We have to know that ministers are available before we plan on distributing Communion under both species.

Another consideration is that the Diocese is mandating a special training session for Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist before we increase the number of Masses in which we will distribute the cup. So, we should recommission the veteran ministers as well as recruit new ones. There will be a sign-up sheet in the vestibule for this purpose. Only those who sign up will be put on the list to be commissioned and be scheduled for Masses.

Here are the qualifications for Extraordinary Ministers of Eucharist:

- Fully initiated Catholics (baptized and confirmed)
- Registered member of St. Timothy Parish
- If married, you should have been married according to Catholic marriage laws.
- You are living as an active Catholic, faithful to the teachings of the church.
- Willing to be scheduled to serve and be responsible to fulfill the commitment.
- If unable to attend a Mass for which you have been scheduled, you will find a substitute minister to replace you.

I expect to have the sign-up sheet in the vestibule next weekend.

Helping a Homeless Mother Living in a Car

St. Vincent de Paul dedicated his life to helping the poor. He founded a community of priests called Vincentians to help with his work with the poor. Today, St. Vincent's work continues at St. Timothy through our Society of St. Vincent de Paul conference (SVDP).

Not having enough money to pay expenses has become the norm for many families. A report by the National Low Income Housing Coalition found that Ohio fails to have an adequate supply of affordable rental housing. This has driven thousands to live in their vehicles. Contrary to popular belief, not all people who live in their vehicles are unemployed. Many simply work jobs that don't pay enough to afford adequate housing. Recently, SVDP received a referral to assist a mother with an 11-year-old son. Even though the mother works at the Speedway/7-11, she had been living out of her car since September. Her concern was finding an apartment since cold weather was approaching. The mother recently filed for divorce and receives no support from the father. After finding an apartment which will allow her to walk to work, members of SVDP provided the mother with financial help, including the cost to move and the security deposit. She was very thankful for the financial assistance from SVDP. Going forward, the mother will make enough at her job to cover her monthly bills associated with the apartment.
