

Helping Families with Food Insecurity

He who is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will repay him for his deed. Proverbs 19:17.

Local food pantries have been struggling to keep up with the significant increase in people needing food after Ohio households received a sharp reduction in the size of their benefits under the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) in March. More than 80% of SNAP beneficiaries are working families and individuals with disabilities or elderly people. The reduction of SNAP benefits, along with the rising costs of food, has been a hardship for Ohio families living paycheck to paycheck or trying to make ends meet on a fixed income.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) is helping families with food insecurity with the food pantry located at St. James the Less Church at 1614 Oakland Park in North Linden. Volunteers from parishes throughout the diocese pack groceries each evening, Monday through Friday. The SVDP Conference at St. Timothy contributes financial support and provides teams that volunteer at the St. James Pantry to supply groceries to over 800 needy clients each month.

The St. James Food Pantry is located in a food desert – an urban area in which it is difficult to buy affordable or good quality fresh food. Many clients do not have the transportation to get to a grocery store which is miles away. The pantry provides healthy meals for the families in this impoverished neighborhood.

Each week, the SVDP conference at St. Timothy collects your nonperishable food items for the St. James Food Pantry in the grocery cart in the church vestibule. The pantry is currently in need of the following food supplies:


- Soup and crackers
