#### WHAT IS THE ADVENT WREATH?

Advent wreaths are traditionally made of evergreen branches, which have long been a symbol of the constancy and faithfulness we aspire to as Christians. Each of the four candles on an Advent wreath has specific meaning. The First Sunday of Advent symbolizes

HOPE. The Second Sunday symbolizes FAITH, and the Third Sunday symbolizes JOY. The Fourth and final Sunday of Advent symbolizes PEACE. # LATEST NEWS FROM SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

Helping a Neighbor Facing Eviction

Since August of 2020, our St. Timothy Conference has partnered with other Society of St. Vincent de Paul organizations (SVDP) and has assisted 215 families with their past due rent and utilities through our home visit program. Most of these families were facing eviction after struggling to make their monthly rent and utility bills. One recent example was Sam, a mother with three children that lives in our St. Timothy neighborhood. Sam worked in a restaurant the last five years until medical emergencies required her to quit her job. Currently, the family's sole source of support was a disability check from her husband suffering from multiple sclerosis. SVDP provided rent assistance to stop eviction proceedings and supplied the family with other resources to apply for additional assistance. Sam was very grateful for our financial help which allowed them to remain in their home. God's own goodness touches the world through our charitable acts. Thanks to all our SVDP contributors for making a real difference in the lives of the poor.
