Practical Ways to Do the Works of Mercy During Lent During Lent, it is a time to show the love of God through our caring and loving actions toward others. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) gives us the opportunity to show the love of Christ through simple acts of kindness. Whether it is providing a sandwich at St. Lawrence Haven or a warm winter coat at the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center, small things can make a difference.
