### Lenten Guidelines:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Everyone 18 years and older and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meals sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to one's needs, but together, they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the rule does not oblige. Catholics should not excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Donations received through SVDP allow us to help our neighbors who are experiencing hardships with their unpaid rent and utilities. Members of SVDP provide assistance through our home visit program. Since August of 2020, our conference, along with

other SVDP organizations, helped 136 families with rent and utilities. Most of these families were struggling and facing eviction.

For example, recently, SVDP received an assistance request. A domestic violence situation left a mother and her daughters homeless. SVDP helped the family with housing payment after the Section 8 voucher could not cover all the housing costs. The single mother is getting back on her feet and the daughters have been reunited with their mother after being in foster care. Throughout the Bible, God's people are reminded to care for those in need. Even if we don't have much, we should use what we do have to help others. Small things can make a difference.
