Mercy Bags for the Homeless

Homelessness has developed into an epidemic in many parts of the United States. The problem is distinguishing between the homeless that really need help and the con artists who prey on human kindness and compassion. Some people are pretending to be homeless as they promote their drug addiction.

The Christian way is to respond to the need. A speaker at the Women's Prayers Breakfast a few years ago who was herself homeless said it is not a good idea to give money to the panhandler. Instead, she suggested providing attention such as a smile and a reassuring word.

One way that you can help homeless people find shelters and other resources is carrying around contact "street cards" for homeless service agencies in Columbus. These cards can help homeless people access information to find shelters, free meals and clothing, healthcare, mental health and substance abuse services. The street cards can be found and printed out at https://columbushomeless.org/.

On Wednesday, April 26 after the 9:00 a.m. Mass, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) will be making "Mercy Bags" for the homeless in the Teachers' Lounge. The Mercy Bags will be stuffed with food items such as Slim Jims, tuna meals, granola bars and bottled water. Each mercy bag will have the street card described above listing the additional resources for the homeless. SVDP members will pass out the Mercy Bags to interested parishioners after Mass to keep in your car to give to those who approach you at street corners.
