Helping Prevent Utility Shutoffs

Your donations allow members of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) to help our neighbors who are experiencing hardships with their unpaid utilities. Studies have shown that utility shutoffs can be extremely disruptive. Loss of energy services such as lighting, heating, cooling, food preservation, and water services have severe negative impacts on the finances, health, and safety of the poor.

Members of SVDP aid in our communities through our

Members of SVDP aid in our communities through our home visit program where we help individuals with unpaid rent and utilities. Recently, SVDP's home visit program received an assistance request from Ray, a blind senior citizen and veteran on a limited income. Ray was facing a rising and unaffordable water bill. His water bill jumped from \$110.00 to over \$4,000.00 due to a water heater that was leaking for a number of months. The blind Veteran risked being disconnected or even losing his home if he could not pay.

SVDP developed a plan to resolve Ray's difficult situation. First, members of the SVDP negotiated with the water company to eliminate some of the water charges. Next, volunteers who were plumbers helped with the installation of the new water heater. Our local SVDP partnered with other conferences to provide the funds to help pay the remaining balance due to prevent the disconnection. Ray was very appreciative that his water services were not shut off, and he was able to remain in his home. Thank you for your financial support which helps SVDP in our mission to help the poor in the community.
