The Reason for our Easter Joy

"Rejoice! Jesus Christ Our Lord is Risen from the Dead. Alleluia." by Deacon Victor Nduaguba

St. Paul's letter to the Philippians harped this more than anything else: "Rejoice in the Lord always; and I say it again: Rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4) For us Christians, these words cannot find more meaning than at Easter. Easter is a time of Joy. Not just joy, but hearty joy, because Christ our Lord and life has defeated death and given us everlasting life. Christ died on Good Friday, carrying our sins on Himself and nailed them to that tree of death, the abode of Satan, where Adam and Eve were deceived into sin that caused the fall. He entered the abode of the "strong man of death" and defeated him, bound him, and set free those in captivity and the bondage of death. At the Resurrection on Easter morning, Christ opened the gate of paradise for man, a place where there would be no more sin and evil, no more temptation and falls, no more sorrows, but happiness forever.
