Helping Families with Food Insecurity during the Summer

For many children in Columbus, the end of the school year means a struggle to obtain food. During the school year, these kids rely on free or reduced-price meal programs. Now that school is out, families must find a way to fill the gap. Considering how high the price of food is right now, two extra daily meals for each child is an additional cost many families cannot afford. This is where the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and their St. Lawrence Haven operation steps in, located at 244 E. Rich Street in downtown Columbus. Volunteers from parishes throughout the diocese make sandwiches and hot meals which feed over 150 people each day. Food is prepared and packed Monday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and distributed from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. at Holy Cross Church. Members of St. Timothy Church make sandwiches for St. Lawrence Haven on the second Sunday of each month after the 9:00 a.m. Mass. Thanks for all who participate each month.

Throughout the Bible, God's people are reminded to care for those in need. Everyone needs food, shelter and water. Even if we don't have much, we should use what we do have to help others. 
