

PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Scottish novelist James Matthew Barrie has written a play that centers around the "servant" of a wealthy family. The poor man is ordered around and about cruelly from

morning to night. His status is the lowest imaginable, sort of like the male version of a Cinderella. One day, the family goes on an ocean voyage. A shipwreck ensues, and the family and the servant are washed ashore on a deserted island. The family is totally helpless in the situation. The servant alone knows what to do. In the days ahead, the servant emerges as the leader of the group. Suddenly, he is seen for what he is and is elevated to the highest status.

The story recalls Jesus' words that many who are last in this life will be first in the next. We can get caught up in judging people by the world's standards rather than by God's. One of the hardest aspects to follow in Christian discipleship is to accept people and situations for what they are, and then try to make the best of them. This is especially true when we put our faith and trust in leadership. As you pray about contributing to "The Appeal," know that your contribution goes a long way in helping the needs of the least of our brothers and sisters. You, as that contributing person, are putting someone else before you.

SOCIETY OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS

Helping a Neighbor Struggling with Cancer Many times our community comes to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) when there is nowhere else to turn. Every one

of your gifts to us makes an immediate and life-changing difference for each family that we feed or assist to prevent rent evictions and utility shutoffs.

Since August of 2020, our St. Timothy Conference has partnered with other SVDP organizations and have assisted 255 families with their past-due rent and utilities through our home visit program. Most of these families were facing eviction after struggling to make their monthly rent and utility bills. One recent example was Kay, a single woman in the North Linden neighborhood, battling cancer without a family support system. Kay worked as a nurse, but exhausted all of her sick leave and was on unpaid medical leave. She finished her final round of chemotherapy and is now cleared to return to work. Kay was unable to make her last month's rent. SVDP provided rent assistance to stop eviction proceedings and supplied her with other resources to apply for additional assistance. Kay was very grateful for our financial help, which allowed her to remain in her home.

We all have have a purpose here on this earth and that is service to God and service to those in need. Thank you for your commitment to making the world a better place through your support of SVDP.
