## SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS

A major message of the New Testament and Jesus Christ is that humanity should do all that it can to help the poor. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) has been putting these words into practice for 170 years. Your financial contributions each month support the following activities:

- Feeding the hungry with a sack lunch five days a week at St. Lawrence Haven.
- Providing food assistance for the poor at the St. James Pantry and a shelter for victims of domestic abuse.
- Furnishing free clothing for the most needy of people at the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center.
- Giving financial assistance to individuals with unpaid rent and utilities.

In the parish vestibule each week, we collect food for the St. James Pantry and clothing for the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center. This month, we are asking for donations of canned soup, excluding tomato soup, since the pantry is currently unable to order this item from their suppliers.
