DEACON'S CORNER Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

"Come to me all of you who are weary, and I will refresh you, take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart, your souls will find rest in me, for my yoke is easy and my burden light."

The Blessed Sacrament is the Sacred Heart of Jesus living and dwelling in our midst, calling us to come to Him. The message of the Sacred Heart is that the Holy Eucharist is not a thing, but a Person, the Person of Our Loving Savior, whose Divine Heart is on fire with deep, personal love for each of us in the Blessed Sacrament.

He said, "I thirst with such a terrible thirst to be loved by you in this Blessed Sacrament. And if you believe in my love in the Blessed Sacrament, if you really believe in my love, then you shall see miracles of my love for I will reign in every heart, in every family, in every country, all over the world. I will establish my kingdom of love and everlasting peace on earth, through the omnipotent, all-powerful love of my Eucharistic heart." (Deuteronomy 30:10-14)

Every Wednesday, we are privileged to have Christ Exposed to us in the Parish Church from 9:00 a.m. Mass until 6:00 p.m., when we close with the Benediction. Helping a Family Facing Eviction Since August of 2020, our St. Timothy Conference



has partnered with other Society of St. Vincent de Paul organizations (SVDP) and have assisted 170 families with their past due rent and utilities. Most of these families were facing eviction after struggling to make their monthly rent and utility bills. One recent example was a family with 4 children, ages 10, 5, 2 and a newborn. The family had no income after the father lost his job and the new baby was in the hospital with medical issues. SVDP provided rent assistance to stop eviction proceedings. A new job for the father and a section 8 housing voucher should allow this struggling family to make the rental payments in the future. The family was very grateful for our financial help which allowed them to remain in their home. Thanks to all our SVDP contributors for making a real difference in the lives of the poor.
