# SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS Clothing the Naked

Dorothy Day, Founder of the Catholic Worker Movement, stated that everything a baptized person does each day should be directly or indirectly related to the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. One of The Corporal Works of Mercy is to clothe the naked. With your donations, The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) is helping those in need by providing support and volunteers to the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center. The mission of the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center is to provide clean clothing and linens in good condition and without cost to needy men, women, and children.

The clothing distribution center is located in the rear of the J.O.I.N building at 578 E. Main Street in Downtown Columbus and is open from Monday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to Noon. Clients are escorted by SVDP volunteers as they select garments and linens on a quota system. Individuals and families are eligible to select the free clothing and linens every 30 days. Your monetary donations are used for purchasing the socks and underwear.

The SVDP Clothing Distribution Center is currently in need of linens (including sheets), blankets, towels, and washcloths. Please deliver them next to the grocery cart in the church lobby. Thank you for your generous support which allows our SVDP conference at St. Timothy to conduct numerous programs to assist the poor in our local community.
