# SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS Helping Elderly Neighbors Facing Eviction

Older adults increasingly face housing affordability challenges. Due to rising housing costs, over 10 million households headed by someone 65 and over are struggling to pay for their housing. To compensate, elderly households often cut back on food and medical care, which can be detrimental for those with chronic health conditions.

One recent example of this situation was an elderly couple in our neighborhood. The couple was confronted with increased medical expenses, making it difficult to pay for their apartment. They suffered from health issues, requiring both walkers and oxygen. After being evicted from their previous apartment for unpaid rent, they needed to downsize to a smaller apartment. We cringed at the thought of seeing this elderly couple being placed out on the streets. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) assisted the elderly couple with the deposit required to move into their more affordable apartment. The elderly couple was very grateful for our financial help, which kept them from being homeless and allowed them to move into their new apartment.

Since August of 2020, our St. Timothy Conference has partnered with other SVDP organizations and have assisted 325 families with their past-due rent and utilities through our home visit program. Most of these families were facing eviction after struggling to make their monthly rent and utility bills. Thank you for your commitment to making our community a better place through your support of SVDP.
