Dear Brothers and Sisters Some questions and concerns have been raised as to the comparison of our two non-envelope giving programs, Electronic Fund

Transfer (EFT) and the "WeShare" program. The Electronic Fund Transfer program receives funds directly from your checking or savings account which is monthly.

One advantage of the "WeShare" program is that you can use your credit card and thus earn points. However, what some parishioners don't know is that a fee is taken from your contribution that goes to the WeShare company, that reduces the amount the parish actually receives. The parish also pays a monthly \$29.00 management fee to the company.

EFT is an advantage to the parish being that your whole contribution benefits the parish. *Have a great week!* Fr. David





Thank you for your generous contributions to St Vincent de Paul (SVDP). With your donations, we provide support and volunteers to the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center. The mission of the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center is to provide clean clothing in good condition and without cost to the needy men, women, and children.

The clothing distribution center is in the rear of the J.O.I.N building at 578 E. Main Street in Downtown Columbus and is open from Monday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m.-Noon. Clients are escorted by SVDP volunteers as they select garments on a quota system. For example, each man receives two pair of trousers and one jacket. Individuals and families are eligible to select the free clothing every 30 days. Your monetary donations are used for purchasing the socks and underwear.

Throughout the Bible, God's people are reminded to care for those in need. Everyone needs food, clothing, and shelter. Even if we don't have much, we should use what we do have to help others. Whether it is providing a sandwich at St. Lawrence Haven or a warm winter coat at the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center, small things can make a difference.
